The survey will be conducted **online**, only takes **20 minutes** to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones.


SRC Zooper Dooper days will be returning in Term 4.


Now that we have entered Spring and the UV is beginning to rise school hats are required to be worn by students at all times while outside

### **Medical Management** Plan € Medication

All children who have been diagnosed with a medical condition including allergies, food/chemical intolerances, anaphylaxis, asthma, epilepsy will need to provide:

- a completed Medical Management Plan with a colour photo
- necessary medication

Please note it is a legal requirement under the Educat & Care National Regulations and the Terms and Conditions for booking that these are provided.

In the interests of child safety, care may be refus on the day should the appropriate documentatio medication or medication not be supplied.

## Child Care Subsidy



Please note that subsidised hours are calculated and allocated by Centrellink on a fortnightly basis. Check Centrelink for eligibility.

# Fortnightly childcare subsidised hours

Each session is calculated using the full service operational h not the hours attended by the child.

Additional Child Care subsidy will not cover any hours beyond the subsidised hours per fortnight.

# Fees for changes to your booking

No Charge \$10.00

When making additional bookings, the \$10.00 fee is eligible for the Child Care Subsidy, which means you may only need to pay the gap, depending on your families' circumstances.

# There are 2 types of Child Care Payments.

## 1. Child Care Subsidy

The **amount you can get** depends on:

- 1 your family's income
- the type of childcare you use
- the hours of recognised activities you and your partner do

90% of Child Care costs can be covered by Child Care Subsidy!



# 2. Additional Child Care Subsidy

This is extra support for some families including:

- grandparents / great grandparents
- 2 families moving from an income support payment to work
- 3 those experiencing temporary hardship
