Pick up will be outside the current Foundation/One classrooms, opposite the Kinder building.

Whole School Transition Program

Once again, we will run a whole school transition program for all our students on Monday 8th, Tuesday 9th and Wednesday 10th of December.

On these three days students will complete an attendance roll call in their 2025 classroom and then shift to their new classroom space for 2026. Where possible, they will also meet their new classroom teacher for next year.

The transition program is carefully designed by our staff to ensure a strong connection, sense of belonging and clear expectations can be established by students and teachers before the beginning of the year.

The transition helps support students' wellbeing and provides a clear understanding of expected routines and classroom process over the holiday period. This helps minimize anxiety, stress or worry over the longer holiday break.

Our students provide feedback at the end of every whole school transition, with virtually 100% of students saying the program is important, worthwhile and can the program even go longer.

With other important events, like Graduation and Christmas concert, we keep whole school transition to three days, so our 2025 classrooms have time to prepare and practice for important end of year celebrations.

I'll provide our families with more information about whole school transition in a future newsletter.




Whether you're helping out in the classroom, on excursions, Parent Club activities or at school camps, completing the **Volunteer Induction** is a must.

The Get Active Kids Voucher Program is now open!

Get in quick as applications will close 13 November or earlier if the budget allocation is fully exhausted.

If your family or child has a Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, you may be eligible for up to \$200 to put towards the cost of your child's participation in sport and active recreation activities.

Important Dates:

Round 9 open to apply for a voucher or reimbursement: 10:00 am Wednesday, 15 October 2025 and will close 13 November or earlier if the budget allocation is fully exhausted.

Reimbursement expenditure dates: from 1 July 2025 to submission of application

Vouchers expiry date: Wednesday, 31 December 2025.

The Get Active Kids Voucher Program helps eligible families get their kids involved in organised sport and active recreation activities by providing financial support for the cost of membership and registration fees.

Eligible children may be able to receive up to \$200 each.

Special consideration also applies for children residing in care services, as well as temporary or provisional visa holders, undocumented migrants, or international students.
